IGALC 2024 meets the academic advancement criteria of relevant institutions, including appointment to associate and professorial positions, in terms of the diversity of participating countries as well as the Scientific and Advisory Board. Abstracts or full texts of the papers presented at the symposium will be published in the Symposium Proceedings Book with ISBN. In addition, participants who wish to do so can apply to journals indexed in the TR Index and the International Index. In this case, since the full text of the presentations will be published in the journal, only the "abstract" will be published in the "symposium book". Presentations will only be published if they are in line with the publication policies and refereeing processes of the journals. Therefore, the processes of the journals are not related to the conference organizing committee.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

To apply for the conference, a brief summary must be submitted, and an English summary is required since the conference is international. The review process for the summary may take up to 5 days. The final decision will be communicated to the applicant without delay.

The guidelines for submitting the summary are as follows:

• Margins: 2.5 cm on all sides

• Font: Times New Roman, 12 points

• Line spacing: 1 cm

• Headings: All letters in uppercase

• Keywords: A minimum of 3 words

• Word count: A minimum of 250 words

Your abstracts should be between 200-300 words. In addition, all authors in the paper must have their name, surname, place of work, the field of study, e-mail addresses, mobile phone numbers, and ORCID numbers.

The summary should be submitted in Word, Doc, or Docx format and must be sent to the specified address within the first **izdasconference2@gmail.com** days of the conference date.

FULL TEXT SUBMISSION

If the applicant wishes to publish the full text of their work in the conference proceedings, they must first have their summary accepted, and the full text must be submitted within the first **izdasconference2@gmail.com** days of the conference date. The similarity index for full-text works must be at least 30%. The guidelines for submitting the full text are as follows:

• Margins: 2.5 cm on all sides

• Font: Times New Roman, 12 points

• Line spacing: 1 cm

- Headings: All letters in uppercase
- Subheadings: All letters in lowercase
- Page count: A minimum of 5 pages, with a maximum of 25 pages.

The full text should include the following sections: Introduction, Literature Review, Methodology, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, and References.

The APA 6 Style should be used for the citation style. In addition to the full text, the applicant's name, affiliation, location, email address, phone number, and ORCID number must be included in the document.
